Discussion Points	 Alison previewed a new map looking at the percentage of 2-5 years old affected by overweight and obesity for 2019 and the designated Ohio Healthy Program sites for that year. This is some new data and opportunities for this working group to consider future strategies. Group discussion: Not all children receive childcare in the zip code in which they live. The visual encourages us to consider how we increase the number of designated sites county-wide. Opportunity for the future: how to engage businesses, in particular those with childcare programs, to get their sites designated. Seeing the benefit of OHP has been a challenge in the past with the business sector. Could explore a partnership with a college student to make the business case for Ohio Healthy Program looking at productivity of current workforce and health of future workforce.
